

Public Agreement

On the Procedure for Publishing Author's Articles

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1. This Public Agreement (hereinafter referred to as the “Agreement”) defines the procedure for publishing author's articles in the “Journal of Human Biology and Clinical Medicine”.

3. The Agreement is offered on the terms and conditions of a public offer in accordance with Article 398 of the Civil Code of the Kyrgyz Republic. In particular, publication of the text of this Agreement on the official website of the “Journal of Human Biology and Clinical Medicine” constitutes an offer addressed to an indefinite circle of persons in order to conclude an agreement on the terms and conditions specified herein.

4. The Agreement is concluded by the author's accession to the Agreement, that is, by accepting the terms and conditions of this Agreement in full, without any conditions, exceptions, and reservations (Article 399 of the Civil Code of the Kyrgyz Republic), after prior coordinated approval of the content of the article between the author and the editorial board.

5. The fact of the author's acceptance of the terms and conditions hereof is that the author sends his/her materials for publication in the Licensee's journals.

6. In these relations, the author acts as the Licensor, and publisher – as the Licensee.

7. The author retains the copyright to his work, and the publisher has the right of first publication under the terms of the [Creative Commons Attribution License International CC-BY](https://creativecommons.org/licenses/by/4.0/), including among others:

- to publish the article in English and distribute its printed version;
- to translate the article in English (for articles in Russian or Kyrgyz) and distribute the printed version of the translation;
- to distribute the electronic version of the article, as well as the electronic version of the English translation of the article (for articles in Russian or Kyrgyz) by any electronic means (placement on the official website of the journal, in electronic databases, repositories, etc.).

8. Confirmation of the distribution of the Licensor's and Licensee's rights is the fact of publication of the author's material in the "Journal of Human Biology and Clinical Medicine" journal.

9. In case of non-performance or improper performance of obligations hereunder, the Parties hereto shall be held liable in accordance with the current legislation of the Kyrgyz Republic.

10. Disputes and disagreements that may arise in connection with the performance of this Agreement shall be resolved through negotiations between the Parties that concluded this Agreement.

11. When performing the terms and conditions hereof, in everything else that does not contradict the terms and conditions hereunder, the Parties shall be guided by the legislation of the Kyrgyz Republic.
